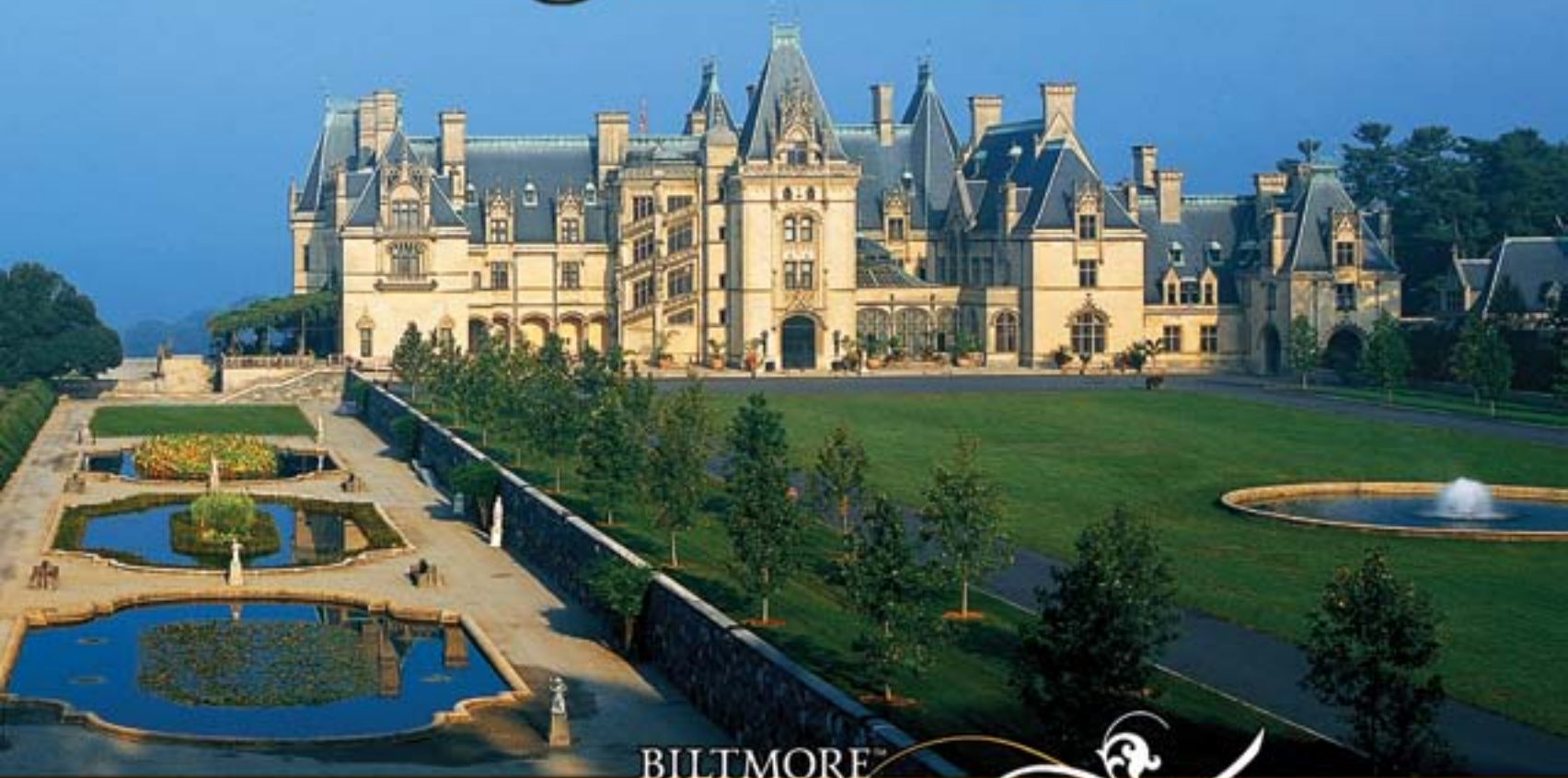

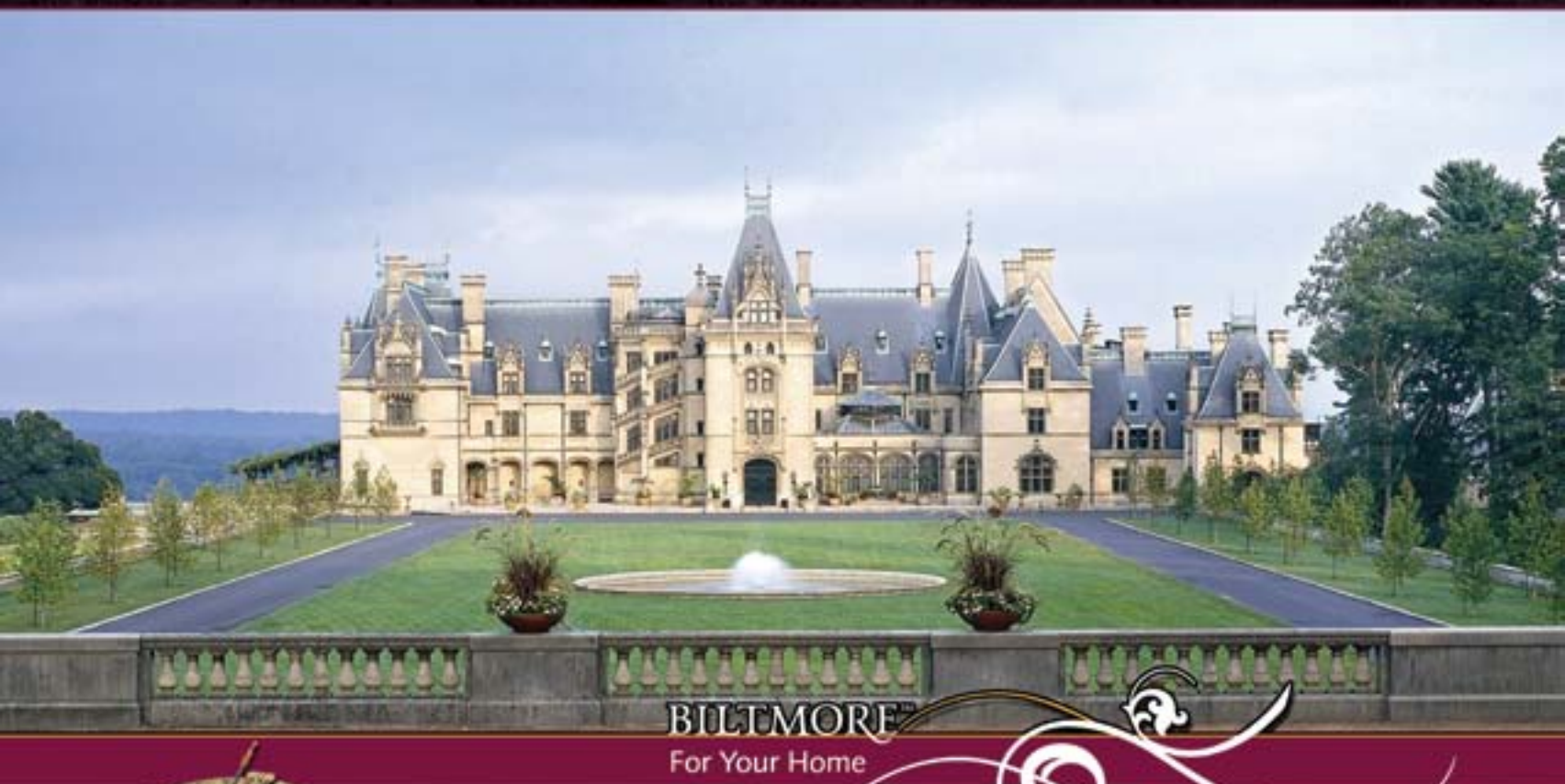

In 1888, upon setting his eyes on the breathtaking Blue Ridge Mountains, George W. Vanderbilt had a vision: to create an extraordinary place unlike any other. In order to realize his dream, Vanderbilt sought the guidance of society architect, Richard Morris Hunt and world-renowned landscape architect Frederick Law Olmsted. Impressed with the young George Vanderbilt, both men began to embark on what would become the pinnacle of their careers. Together they created a 250 room masterpiece in stone which is, to this day, the largest privately owned residence in America.

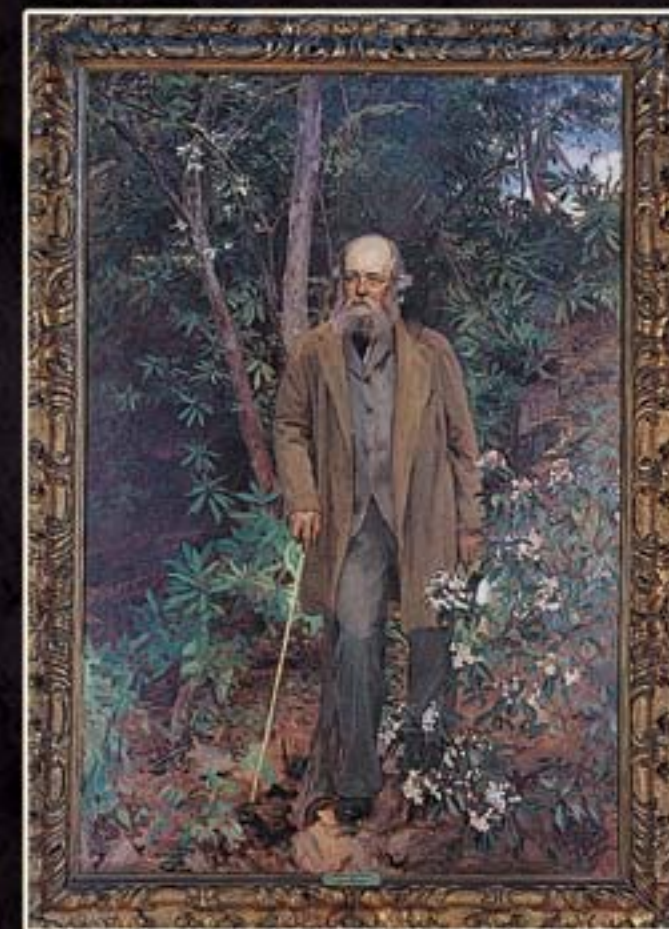

*D*rawing on their same techniques, we sought to create a collection honoring the skills of those such as Karl Bitter, the Viennese sculptor credited for various works throughout Biltmore. We also drew from the visionary legacy left by Olmsted and Hunt to craft outdoor statues, benches, pedestals, and various other architectural elements.



*A*t Unique Stone, we began our collaboration with Biltmore by seeking inspiration within the gardens, grounds, and magnificent masonry much the same way that Vanderbilt sought the right pieces for his estate. Our sculptors found inspiration in the architectural array provided by the early artisans of Biltmore House that has withstood the test of time for over a century.

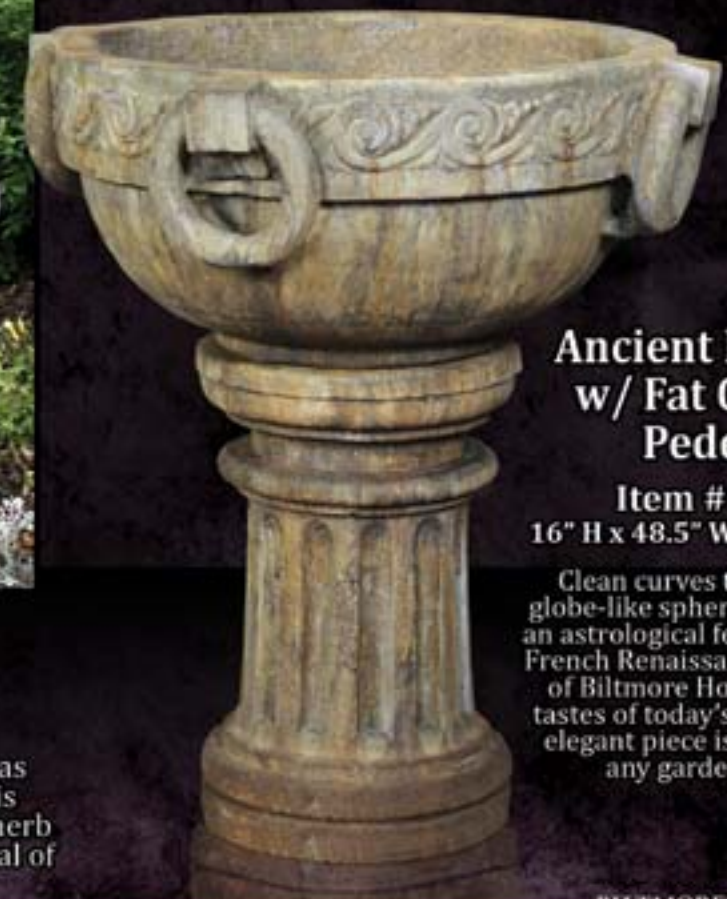

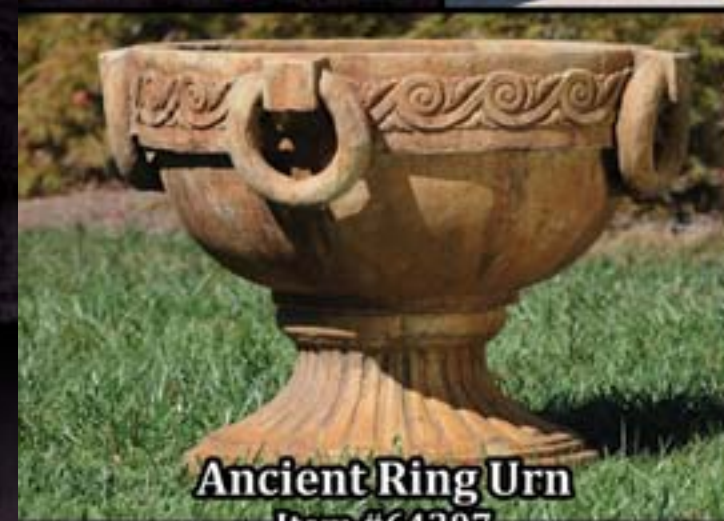

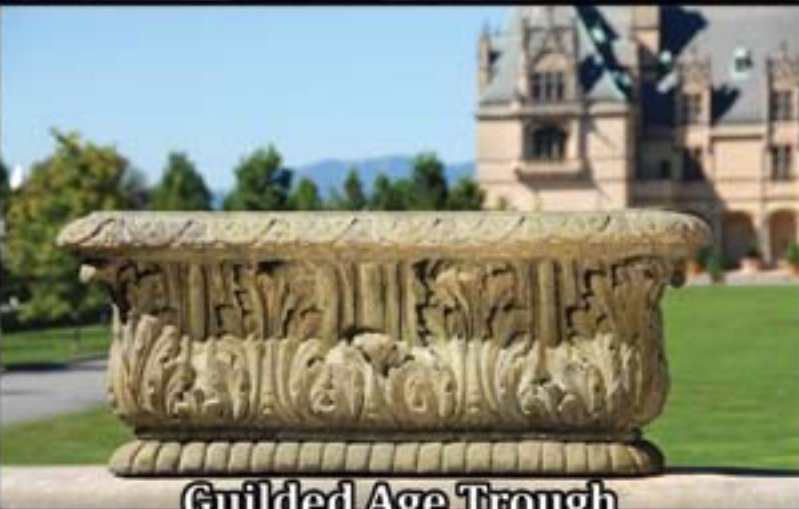

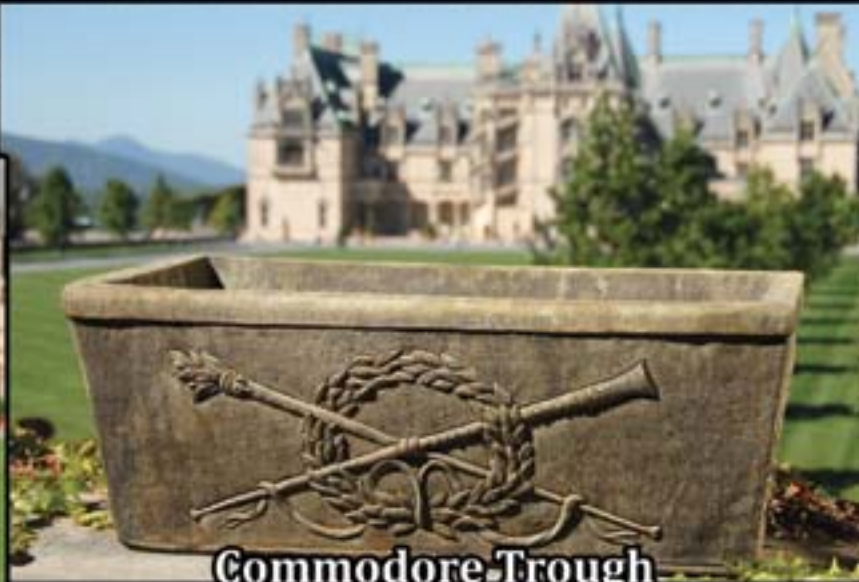


**Gilded Age Trough**
